Paper Roll Binoculars

Exploring the world around us with binoculars can be a good way to find new things. Even though these binoculars won't help you see farther, they will help focus on a specific area.

You'll need:

- 2 paper rolls
- Yarn or string
- Scissors or hole punch
- Glue or tape
- Paper
- Coloring supplies



What to do:

1. Decorate the paper with the coloring supplies.
2. Tape or glue the two rolls together.
3. Wrap the decorated paper around the rolls and tape or glue in place.
4. Use scissors or a hole punch to cut a small hole on the outside of each roll about a half inch from the top.
5. Take one end of your yarn and thread it through the hole. Tie a knot to secure it. Do the same thing with the other end of the yarn.
6. Now you're ready to start exploring! What can you see?
