They are expected to be experts in current and upcoming museum programming, and to help ensure that the rest of the team remains up to date on ongoing events. Due to the nature of museum scheduling, VE Staff are expected to be available both Saturdays and Sundays to provide extra support on our busiest days.

This position is heavily based on customer service and leadership skills. It is dependent on the staff member facilitating a fun and safe learning environment for a diverse group of audiences, and expects those in the position not only to maintain but to actively promote a culture of service during their shifts.
