Arts and cultural organizations, libraries, historical societies, schools, festivals, and more consult the Roster to hire traditional artists to perform, display, demonstrate or discuss their traditional arts. Artists accepted onto the roster are responsible for setting their own fee structures (OFN does note a default \$250/day plus expenses), and create their own programs in collaboration with hiring organizations. OFN is not a booking agent; we refer organizations to the Roster for direct contact with artists.
