


Geology Crossword Puzzle

- 9. The sweeping away of weathered rock particles by water, wind, ice, and gravity.
- 10. A metamorphic rock that forms from intense heat and pressure below the Earth's surface.

Down:

- 1. A red-hot liquid below the Earth's surface.
- 2. This is an igneous rock that forms from cooled magma.
- 3. A sedimentary rock that forms from sand-size minerals or rock grains.
- 4. The breaking down of rocks through wind, water, animals, chemicals, and plants.
