

Make your own beads

You don't have to buy beads. Make your own out of paper, glue, and a pencil!

You'll need:

- Paper
- Glue
- Pencil or a straw

What to do:

- 1. Find papers in four different colors, either construction paper or magazines. Or color or paint plain paper in four different colors.
- 2. Cut long, thin, strips of the paper. The width of the paper will be the width of your beads—try to make them all the same.
- 3. Turn the paper over and coat the underside in a thin layer of glue, leaving about ½ inch without glue—this is where the pencil will go.
- 3. Starting with the end without glue, roll it around your pencil with the color side facing out.
- 4. Carefully slide it off the end of the pencil. You now have a bead!
- 5. Repeat for as many beads as you need to make your bracelet.
