Handprint Earth Craft

Show your love for our home planet by creating a handprint Earth.

Materials needed:

- Blue construction paper
- Scissors
- Green paint and a paint brush
- Markers, crayons, or colored pencils



What to do:

1. Draw a large circle on the blue paper.
2. Take green paint and put it on your hand (use a paint brush to get an even coat of paint) and then make a handprint in the center of the circle on the blue paper. If you don't have green paint you can substitute green markers, crayons or colored pencils. Just trace your hand on the paper and fill it in with green.
3. Add other green areas for land.
4. Once the paint has dried, cut out around the circle.
5. Display it in your home to celebrate Earth Day every day of the year!
