## Paper Flower Craft

Create your own flowers out of paper to decorate your space!

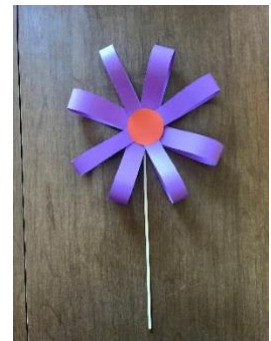
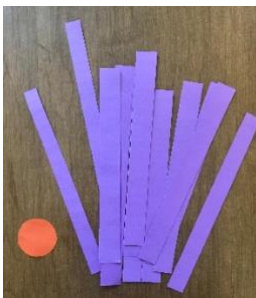
### Materials needed:

- Paper of various colors
- Scissors
- A straw, a small stick, or other item for the stem
- Glue or glue stick and tape



### What to do:

1. Cut out a small circle of paper, this will be the center of your flower.
2. Cut small strips of another color paper. Make them about half an inch wide by 5 or 6 inches long. You will need multiple strips.
3. Glue or tape the ends of the strips together to make paper loops. You will need quite a few for your flower.
4. Start by gluing four in a "X" shape on the back of your flower and then add the rest in between.
5. Finally, glue or tape your straw or stick to the back of your flower.
