Bird Feeder

Use an old toilet paper roll or pine cone to help feed the birds in your neighborhood!

Materials needed:

- A pine cone, conifer cone, or a used toilet paper roll
- Peanut Butter and something to spread it with
- Bird seed
- Some string or twine

Mess alert! You may want to do this activity outside.

What to do:

1. Take a kitchen utensil and spread peanut butter on your toilet paper roll or pine cone, be sure to get a nice even coat all around it.
2. Pour some bird seed onto a plate.
3. Roll your toilet paper roll or pine cone in the bird seed, coating it on all sides.
4. Use a string or some twine to hang up your new bird feeder near your home.
5. Enjoy watching the birds eat their tasty treat!
