Seed-Growing Experiment

Just like gophers helped plants come back to Mount St. Helens after the 1980 eruption, you can help bring native plants to your neighborhood with this fun seed-growing experiment!

Materials needed:

- Seeds of any kind
- Paper towels
- Ziploc bags
- Water

What to do:

- 1. Get a paper towel and run it under water until it's wet but not dripping.
- 2. Fold the paper towel in half, then fold it in half again.
- 3. Place the folded paper towel in the Ziploc bag.
- 4. Take your seeds and place a few of them in the bag between the paper towel and the plastic.
- 5. Put the bag near a window. Wait a few days and enjoy watching your seeds grow into plants! Once they are big enough you can plant them in small pots.
